Prohibits the careless use of a firearm, bow and arrow, or crossbow, including using the weapon in a way that poses a hazard to any person or property. Provides several additional restrictions on hunting in Tyrrell County. A violation is a class 3 misdemeanor. Provides for enforcement of the act. Applies only to Tyrrell County. H 1176. TYRRELL COUNTY HUNTING. Filed 3/28/07. Senate committee substitute adopted 7/5/07 makes the following changes to 1st edition. Provides that a violation of the act is a Class 3 misdemeanor, unless the conduct is covered under a different law providing greater punishment.

H 1176. TYRRELL COUNTY HUNTING. Filed 3/28/07. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Clarifies that if a person has a permit to carry a handgun concealed, the prohibition on possessing a loaded firearm on certain rights-of-way and highways does not apply to the handgun.
