Corrects title to accurately reflect the contents of the bill and conforms title to reflect the new provision, so that the title now reads: TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON CHARGED WITH A SEX OFFENSE WHO IS ORDERED TO BE TESTED FOR A SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED DISEASE MUST BE TESTED WITHIN FORTY-EIGHT HOURS OF THE COURT ORDER AND TO PROVIDE THAT HIV TESTING UNDER THESE PROVISIONS WILL USE THE VIRAL LOAD DETECTION METHOD OF DETERMINING HIV INFECTION.
