Adds an appropriation of \$25,000 for 2007-08 from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of the University of North Carolina for use by the NC School of Science and Math (NCSSM) to study: (1) an alternate program for NCSSM graduates that would require three years of science or math teaching in NC in exchange for the free tuition and (2) why students from middle-to-low income families are less likely to attend the NCSSM than students from affluent families. Makes conforming changes to the title.
