H 1276. REMOVE RESTRICTION/LEO DISABILITY BENEFITS. Filed 3/30/07. *TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT THAT LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS HAVE ONE YEAR OF CREDITABLE SERVICE IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR DISABILITY RETIREMENT BENEFITS UNDER THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR INJURIES INCURRED IN THE LINE OF DUTY.*

Amends GS 128-27(c) to remove the one-year service requirement for disability retirement for a law enforcement officer, a fireman as defined in GS 58-86-25, or a rescue squad worker as defined in GS 58-86-30, if the person became disabled in the line of duty. Effective July 1, 2007.
