H 1338. RAISE PROJECT VALUE LIMITS/ELEC. CONTRACTORS. Filed 4/5/07. AUTHORIZING THE ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS BOARD TO RAISE THE PROJECT VALUE LIMITS FOR LICENSE CLASSIFICATIONS UNDER THE LAWS REGULATING ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS.

Amends GS 87-43.3 to increase the maximum value of projects limited licensed electrical contractors may work on in a single contracting project from \$25,000 to \$40,000 and to increase the maximum value of projects intermediate licensed electrical contractors may work on in a single contracting project from \$75,000 to \$110,000. Also authorizes the Electrical Contracts Board to modify the project value limitations no more than every three years based on changes in the electrical project cost index.

H 1338. RAISE PROJECT VALUE LIMITS/ELEC. CONTRACTORS. Filed 4/5/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Modifies the proposed changes to GS 87-43.3 to increase the maximum value of projects limited licensed electrical contractors may work on in a single contracting project from the proposed \$40,000 to \$100,000 and to increase the maximum value of projects intermediate licensed electrical contractors may work on in a single contracting project from the proposed \$110,000 to \$200,000. Also allows the State Licensing Board for General Contractors to modify the project value limitations up to the maximum amounts in the section (was, modify the project value limitations in the section) for limited and intermediate licenses no more than once every three years (was, no more than every three years) based on changes in the project cost index for electrical projects. Sets the project value limitation for the limited classification at \$40,000 and for the Intermediate classification at \$110,000 effective when the act becomes law and until changed by permanent rule adopted by the board.

H 1338. RAISE PROJECT LIMITS/ELEC./GEN. CONTRACTORS (NEW). Filed 4/5/07. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Modifies GS 87-43.3 to provide that electrical contracting licenses classified as *limited* or *intermediate* permit licensees to engage in a single electrical contracting project of a value set by the State Board of Examiners of Electrical Contractors not to exceed \$100,000 (limited) or \$200,000 (intermediate). Amends GS 87-43.2(a) to require applicants for licensure or license renewal as an electrical contractor to furnish a bonding ability statement verifying the applicant's ability to provide performance bonds based on value limits established in the proposed amendments to GS 87-43.3. Amends GS 87-10(a) to provide that (1) the holder of an intermediate license may act as a general contractor for any single project with a value of \$1 million (was, \$700,000) and (2) the holder of a limited license may do so for any single project with a value of \$500,000 (was \$350,000). Makes the act effective October 1, 2007 (was, when it becomes law).
