H 1340. AMATEUR RADIO ANTENNAS. Filed 4/5/07. TO RECOGNIZE THE VALUE OF AMATEUR RADIO COMMUNICATIONS BY REQUIRING CITY AND COUNTY ORDINANCES REGULATING ANTENNAS TO REASONABLY ACCOMMODATE AMATEUR RADIO COMMUNICATIONS.

Enacts new GS 160A-383.3 and GS 153A-341.2 requiring city and county ordinances regulating the placement, screening, or height of amateur radio operator antennas based on health, safety, or aesthetics, to accommodate amateur radio communications and be the minimum practicable regulation necessary. Also prohibits cities and counties from restricting amateur radio operator antennas that are 90 feet or less unless it is necessary to meet health, safety, or aesthetic objectives.
