H 1347. FALSE REPORT/MASS VIOLENCE AT SCHOOL. Filed 4/5/07. TO MAKE IT A CRIMINAL OFFENSE TO MAKE A FALSE REPORT CONCERNING A THREAT OF MASS VIOLENCE ON EDUCATIONAL PROPERTY.

Enacts new GS 14-277.5 making it a Class H felony to knowingly communicate a false report to another person that an act of mass violence is going to occur on educational property (as defined in GS 14-269.2) or at a curricular or extracurricular activity sponsored by a school. Specifies that *communicate* includes only communications by mail, phone, text message, fax, electronic mail, or other electronic communication. Defines mass violence as physical injury that a reasonable person would conclude could lead to permanent physical, mental, or emotional injury or the death of two or more people. Provides that the court may order a person convicted under this act to pay restitution, including costs and consequential damages. Effective for offenses committed on or after December 1, 2007.

In the first edition, *communicate* was specifically limited to communications by mail, text message, phone, fax, electronic mail, or other electronic means.
