H 1357. MILITARY CHILDREN MAY ATTEND PUBLIC SCHOOLS. Filed 4/5/07. TO ALLOW A CHILD WHO IS NOT A DOMICILIARY OF A LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT TO ATTEND, WITHOUT PAYMENT OF TUITION, THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THAT UNIT IF THE CHILD RESIDES WITH AN ADULT WHO IS A DOMICILIARY OF THAT UNIT BECAUSE THE CHILD'S PARENT OR GUARDIAN HAS BEEN CALLED TO ACTIVE MILITARY DUTY OR ACTIVE DUTY WITH THE NATIONAL GUARD.

Amends GS 115C-366(a3)(1) as title indicates. Requires that evidence of the deployment be submitted with the residency affidavits required under GS 115C-366(a3)(3). Specifies that for the purposes of the provision, *active duty* does not include periods of less than 30 days.
