H 1413. ADD VETERAN TO STATE PERSONNEL COMM. Filed 4/11/07. *PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATED APPOINTMENT OF A VETERAN OF THE ARMED FORCES TO THE STATE PERSONNEL COMMISSION.*

Amends GS 126-2 to increase the number of members of the State Personnel Commission from nine to ten to allow for the inclusion of a veteran of the armed forces, appointed by the Governor after considering nominations from the Veterans' Affairs Commission. The initial veteran's term expires June 30, 2009, and subsequent appointees serve for six years. Makes conforming change.

H 1413. ADD VETERAN TO STATE PERSONNEL COMM. Filed 4/11/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Removes all of the proposed amendments to GS 126-2 and instead amends GS 126-2(b)(3) to require that of the two state employees subject to the State Personnel Act serving in nonexempt positions that are appointed by the Governor to the State Personnel Commission, one must be a veteran of the armed forces appointed upon nomination by the Veterans' Affairs Commission. Provides that the act applies upon the next vacancy occurring on or after the date it becomes law.
