H 1414. CREDITABLE SERVICE/EMPLOYEES IN ARMED FORCES. Filed 4/11/07. TO REVISE THE LAW PROVIDING FOR CREDITABLE SERVICE IN THE TEACHERS' AND STATE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR MEMBERS WHO SERVED IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.

Amends GS 135-4(g) to provide that members of the armed forces who return to work as teachers or state employees within two years after being discharged are to be credited with prior service for their time in the military for the maximum period they are entitled to reemployment under federal law. Also provides that the employee's salary during that period of service is the salary the employee would have received had they remained continuously employed, if the determination of that salary is reasonably certain (was, salaries are based on salaries paid to employees immediately before entering the armed forces). Provides for the calculation of the employee's salary when the determination is not reasonably certain. Effective July 1, 2007. Intro. by Martin, Coleman, J. Harrell, T. Harrell. GS 135

H 1414. CREDITABLE SERVICE/UNIFORMED SERV. EMPLOYEES (NEW). Filed 4/11/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Amends GS 135-4(g) to provide that teachers and state employees who served in the uniformed services as defined in the Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act of 1994 (was, who served in the US armed forces), and who return to state employment within two years of being honorably discharged are credited with prior service for the period of service in the uniformed services (was, in the US armed forces). Makes a conforming title change.
