Amends GS 163-278.13 to provide that the limitations on contributions to political party executive committees by candidates or candidate campaign committees and contributions by political party executive committees to candidates or candidate campaign committees apply to any national, state, district or county executive committee of any political party. Defines *candidate campaign committee*. Effective for contributions made or accepted on or after January 1, 2008. Intro. by Current. GS 163

H 1432. POLITICAL PARTY CAMPAIGN FUND-RAISING STUDY (NEW). Filed 4/11/2007. House committee substitute deletes all provisions of the 1st edition and replaces it with AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY WHETHER THE STATE SHOULD LIMIT THE ROLE OF POLITICAL PARTIES IN CAMPAIGN FUND-RAISING. As title indicates. Authorizes the Legislative Research Commission (LRC) to make an interim report to the 2008 session and requires the LRS to make a final report to the 2009 General Assembly. Effective July 1, 2007.
