Filed 2/8/07. *TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION OF NORTH CAROLINA TO REQUIRE A THREE-FIFTHS VOTE FOR THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO LEVY STATE TAXES.* Requires a referendum during the November 2008 general election on a proposed amendment to Section 23 of Article II of the NC Constitution to require that any law increasing a tax rate or levying a new tax must be approved by a three-fifths vote of the General Assembly, and to make technical changes. Does

not apply to laws repealing or restricting a specific tax preference or authorizing one or more local taxing units to levy a tax.
