Amends GS 20-7(f)(2) to require a commercial driver's license with a *vehicles carrying* passengers and a *school bus* endorsement that is issued to a licensee certified to drive a school bus in North Carolina to expire on the licensee's birthday three years after it is issued. Effective July 1, 2007.
