H 1575. SMALL ENGINE OFF-ROAD VEHICLE RESTRICTIONS. Filed 4/17/07. TO PREVENT THE USE OF MOTORCYCLES AND ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES THAT HAVE ENGINE SIZES THAT ARE FIFTY CUBIC CENTIMETERS OR LESS FROM PARTICIPATING IN ANY EVENT WITH MOTORCYCLES OR ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES THAT HAVE ENGINE SIZES THAT ARE GREATER THAN FIFTY CUBIC CENTIMETERS.

Enacts new GS 20-146.1A making it a Class 3 misdemeanor to operate or allow the operation of a motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle with an engine size of 50 cubic centimeters or less in any event with motorcycles or all-terrain vehicles with engines greater than 50 cubic centimeters. Effective December 1, 2007, and applicable to offenses committed on or after that date.
