**H 1617. INVESTIGATIONS OF DEADLY FORCE.** Filed 4/18/07. *TO REQUIRE INVESTIGATIONS OF THE USE OF DEADLY FORCE BY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.*

Enacts new GS 147-90 to require an investigation of every instance in which a private citizen is killed as a result of the use of a firearm by a law enforcement officer in the line of duty, upon request of the surviving spouse or next of kin of the private citizen, if the request is made within 180 days after the death. Provides that statements prepared by or on behalf of a district attorney pursuant to this statute are not public records and may be released by the district attorney only as provided in GS 132-1.4 or other applicable law. Effective October 1, 2007, and applies to acts occurring on or after that date.
