H 1687. LEGISLATIVE/STATE EMPLOYEE MILEAGE. Filed 4/18/07. TO PROVIDE LEGISLATORS WITH THE SAME MILEAGE RATES AS STATE EMPLOYEES AND TO ESTABLISH BOTH STATE EMPLOYEE AND LEGISLATIVE RATES AT THE FEDERAL EMPLOYEE RATE FOR TRAVEL.

Amends GS 138-6(a)(1), as title indicates and to authorize any state agency to require an employee to use a state-provided vehicle and, if one is available but declined, to pay a lower rate than the rate set by the Internal Revenue Service. Effective July 1, 2007. Amends GS 120-3.1(a)(1) and (2) to set the legislative reimbursement rates at the federal employee rate for travel. **H 1687. LEGISLATIVE/STATE EMPLOYEE MILEAGE.** Filed 4/18/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Changes the effective date of the amendment to GS 138-6(a)(1) (state employee mileage rate) from July 1, 2007, to September 1, 2007.

H 1687. EMPLOYEE AND OFFICER ALLOWANCES (NEW). Filed 4/18/07. Senate committee substitute deletes the content of the 2nd edition and replaces it with AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE DIRECTOR OF THE BUDGET SHALL ANNUALLY SET ALL MILEAGE RATES, SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCES, AND PER DIEM FOR STATE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES. Requires the Director of the Budget to set the weekly travel allowance or mileage rate reimbursement for the use of privately owned automobiles by state officers or employees and the subsistence or per diem allowance of any state officer or employee. Requires the rates to be set by November 15 of each year with any changes effective the first day of the next calendar year, unless a later effective date is required as to any officer.

**H 1687. EMPLOYEE AND OFFICER ALLOWANCES.** Filed 4/18/07. Senate amendment makes the following changes to 3rd edition.

Specifies that the weekly travel allowance or mileage reimbursement rate for the use of privately owned vehicles by any state officer or employee is to be set at a uniform rate by the Director of the Budget.
