Enacts new GS 74F-10.1 to exempt (1) a locksmith issued a license under Chapter 74F of the General Statutes, who is in active practice as a locksmith, and who has at least 20 consecutive years of experience as a locksmith; or (2) a locksmith issued a license under Chapter 74F of the General Statutes who is 60 years of age or older and has at least 10 consecutive years of experience as a locksmith.

**H 1746. EXEMPT CERTAIN LOCKSMITHS/CONTINUING ED REQS.** Filed 4/18/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Modifies proposed GS 74F-10.1 to add the requirements for exemption from continuing education requirements that (1) a locksmith with at least 20 years of experience must also have held a county or municipal license for at least 20 consecutive years; and (2) a locksmith who is 60 years or older with at least 10 years of experience must be in active practice as a locksmith, and must also have held a county or municipal business license for at least 10 consecutive years.
