H 1805. NO LIMITS ON MOTOR FUEL PURCHASES. Filed 4/18/07. TO AMEND THE MOTOR FUELS MARKETING ACT BY PROHIBITING SELLERS FROM LIMITING THE QUANTITY OF MOTOR FUEL OFFERED FOR SALE.

Amends GS 75-88 to specify that no entity may limit the quantity of motor fuel sold from a motor fuel pump to any one customer to a quantity less than the entire supply that is owned or possessed by the seller that the seller is authorized to sell at the place of sale unless preempted by a state of emergency. Fuel purchased must be dispensed into an approved container. Each violation of the act is a separate offense punishable by a civil penalty of up to \$5,000. Injunctive relief may also be sought. Effective Oct. 1, 2007 for sales on or after that date.
