**H 1839. 30-DAY WAIT/UNSOLICITED MAILING/ATTORNEYS.** Filed 4/18/07. TO PROVIDE A THIRTY-DAY WAITING PERIOD BEFORE AN ATTORNEY IS ALLOWED TO SEND UNSOLICITED WRITTEN COMMUNICATIONS TO PROSPECTIVE CLIENTS.

Enacts new GS 84-39 to make it a Class 1 misdemeanor for a licensed attorney to send an unsolicited written communication to a prospective client for the purposes of obtaining employment concerning a traffic citation or action for personal injury or wrongful death or otherwise relating to an accident or disaster that the addressee was involved in, within 30 days after the accident. Makes conforming change to GS 84-38. Intro. by Justice. GS 84
