H 205. REPEAL OUT-OF-STATE TUITION EXEMPTION. Filed 2/14/07. TO REPEAL A BUDGET PROVISION GRANTING IN-STATE TUITION TO CERTAIN FULL SCHOLARSHIP STUDENTS. Repeals GS 116-143.6, which authorizes the Board of Trustees of a constituent institution of the University of North Carolina to consider as residents of North Carolina all students who receive full scholarships to the institution from entities recognized by the institution and attend the institution as undergraduate students. Provides that the repeal of the statute does not affect the receipt of full scholarships for the 2006-07 and 2007-08 academic years by students who received the scholarships before the repeal. H 205. MODIFY OUT-OF-STATE TUITION EXEMPTION (NEW). Filed 2/14/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Deletes the proposed repeal of GS 116-143.6, which authorizes UNC constituent institutions to treat undergraduates who receive full scholarships as if they were NC residents. Instead amends GS 116-143.6(b) to limit the statute to full scholarships based on academic merit. Provides that the limitation does not affect scholarships for the 2006-07 and 2007-08 academic years if they were received before the act became law. Conforms the title.
