H 2122. JACKSON/NO SHINING LIGHT ON DEER. Filed 5/14/08. TO PROHIBIT THE SHINING OF LIGHTS IN DEER AREAS IN JACKSON COUNTY.

Prohibits the intentional shining of direct light on a deer or the sweeping of a light in search of deer between one-half hour after sunset and one-half hour before sunrise. Lists examples of lawful uses of lights at night. Makes violation of the law a Class 3 misdemeanor and a second or subsequent violation within one year a Class 2 misdemeanor. Provides that enforcement is by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by other peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction. Applies to Jackson County only. Effective October 1, 2008. Intro. by Haire.
