H 213. REMOVE LOCAL RETIREMENT EARNINGS CAP. Filed 2/14/07. TO ELIMINATE THE POSTRETIREMENT EARNINGS RESTRICTION ON RETIREES UNDER THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND ENABLE RETIRED LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES TO RETURN TO WORK WITHOUT LOSING RETIREMENT BENEFITS. Repeals GS 128-24(5)c., which provides that if a person retired from local government returns to work as a local government employee on a part-time or temporary basis, by contract or otherwise, the retiree's benefits are suspended annually at the point in each year of reemployment that the retiree earns above a specified amount and reinstated each January 1. [GS 128-24(5)d. provides that the retirement allowance paid to a beneficiary who returns to service as a local government employee will cease as of the first of the month following the month in which the beneficiary returns to service.] Effective July 1, 2007.
