Enacts new Article 6I of GS Chapter 136 to create an interstate compact and coordinate efforts to establish

an Inland Port among the states of North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, and the Commonwealth of Virginia. Establishes a 20-member Compact Commission. Effective upon enactment by all the participating states.

H 2258. INLAND PORT INTERSTATE COMPACT STUDY (NEW). Filed 5/20/08. House committee substitute deletes the contents of the 1st edition and replaces it with AN ACT TO CREATE THE INLAND PORT INTERSTATE COMPACT STUDY COMMITTEE. Creates a sixteen-member Inland Port Interstate Compact Study Committee (Committee), the purpose of which is to study whether NC should enter into a compact with South Carolina, Tennessee, and Virginia, to coordinate efforts to establish an Inland Port. Establishes how members of the Committee must be appointed, how cochairs of the Committee are to be designated, how vacancies on the Committee must be filled, and where the Committee may meet. Requires the Committee to make its final report by the convening of the 2009 General Assembly. Provides that the Committee terminates at the earlier of the filing of its final report or the convening of the 2009 General Assembly. Allows the Legislative Services Commission to allocate funds to fund the work of the Committee.
