H 2289. STUDY RAISING COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE AGE. Filed 5/20/08. TO DIRECT THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO STUDY THE IMPACTS OF RAISING THE COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE AGE FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL ATTENDANCE FROM SIXTEEN TO SEVENTEEN OR EIGHTEEN, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION ON DROPOUT PREVENTION AND HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION.

As title indicates. Directs the Board of Governors of the University of North Carolina to submit a report of its findings and recommendations, no later than November 15, 2008, to the Joint Legislative Commission on Dropout Prevention and High School Graduation, and the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee.
