H 2310. VEHICLE REGISTRATION/INSPECTION CHANGES. Filed 5/20/08. TO MAKE CHANGES TO THE LAWS GOVERNING VEHICLE REGISTRATION AND INSPECTION. AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE TRANSPORTATION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.

Deletes GS 20-66(k), which would have required, effective October 1, 2008, that expired registration plates be surrendered to the Division of Motor Vehicles within 120 days of expiration. Amends GS 20-183.4(b)(4) to require, effective October 1, 2008, that safety inspections stations have equipment and software approved by DMV to transfer information to DMV electronically. Amends GS 20-183.4C(a)(4) to require that a new or used vehicle acquired by a North Carolina resident from outside the state be inspected before (was, within 10 days after) the vehicle is registered with DMV. Amendments to GS 20-183.4C(a)(5) require that a vehicle owned by a new resident of North Carolina who transfers the registration from another state be inspected before (was, within ten days) the vehicle is registered with DMV. Changes to GS 20-183.4C(a)(9) require that a used vehicle acquired from a private sale in North Carolina be inspected before the vehicle is registered with DMV unless the vehicle has received a passing inspection within the previous 12 months. Amendments to GS 20-184.4C(a)(10) require that an unregistered vehicle be inspected before registration with DMV or before a transferred registration expires. Effective October 1, 2008.
