H 2317. DOT BID LIMITS/HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE/PER YEAR. Filed 5/20/08. TO MAKE THE INFORMAL BID LIMITS FOR DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE CONTRACTS PER YEAR LIMITS FOR MULTIYEAR CONTRACTS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE TRANSPORTATION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.

GS 136-28.1(b) permits informal bidding of highway construction, maintenance, and repair contracts of \$1.2 million or less. This bill amends the statute to provide that contracts for maintenance which will be \$1.2 million or less *per year* may be informally bid. The bill makes a corresponding change in GS 136-28.10(a), which permits informal bids for Highway Fund or Highway Trust Fund construction, maintenance, and repair projects of \$500,000 or less. Also amends GS 136-28.1(a), which requires full bidding for construction and repair projects of more than \$1.2 million to make the section applicable to contracts for construction, maintenance, operations, and repair.
