H 2319. DMV EMPLOYEE CRIMINAL HISTORY. Filed 5/20/08. TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO PROVIDE TO THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION THE CRIMINAL HISTORY OF APPLICANTS AND EMPLOYEES, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE TRANSPORTATION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.

Enacts a new GS 114-19.24 to authorize the Department of Justice to provide the Division of Motor Vehicles with the criminal history of any applicant or employee involved with identity information and the manufacture or production of drivers licenses and identification cards. Requires DMV to provide a signed consent form, fingerprints of the applicant and other identifying information, which must be kept confidential. Allows the Department of Justice to charge a fee for the actual cost of criminal history check.
