H 2455. INCREASE OXFORD MOTOR VEHICLE TAX. Filed 5/21/08. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Deletes the amendment to GS 20-97(a) to increase the maximum a city may levy on any license or privilege on a vehicle resident to \$20 and, instead, amends GS 20-97(b) to increase the maximum amount a city or town may levy for a general municipal vehicle tax on any vehicle resident to \$20 (was, \$5). Clarifies that this section applies to Oxford only.

Effective when Oxford acts to levy an additional tax under this act, makes a conforming amendment to section 2 of SL 1987-610 to remove Oxford as a city to which the section applies, so that it no longer imposes a \$10 limit on Oxford when levying a motor vehicle tax.

Makes a conforming change to the title.

## July 1, 2008

SL 2008-29 (H 2455). INCREASE OXFORD MOTOR VEHICLE TAX. AN ACT TO PERMIT THE CITY OF OXFORD TO INCREASE ITS MOTOR VEHICLE PRIVILEGE TAX FROM TEN DOLLARS TO TWENTY DOLLARS FOR EACH RESIDENT VEHICLE LOCATED IN THE TOWN. Summarized in Daily Bulletin 5/21/08 and 6/10/08. Enacted June 30, 2008. Section 2 is effective on the date the City of Oxford acts to levy an additional tax under this act. The remainder is effective June 30, 2008.
