H 246. RECALL ELECTIONS. Filed 2/15/07. TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION OF NORTH CAROLINA TO ALLOW RECALL ELECTIONS FOR ANY OFFICE ESTABLISHED BY THE CONSTITUTION. Subject to approval by the voters in the November 2008 election, amends Article VI of the NC Constitution to add new Section 11 to authorize recall elections of elected constitutional officers, upon petition of at least 25% of the registered voters in the area covered by the election that put the person in office. No recall is allowed in the last six months of a person's term of office. Only one recall election is allowed within a single term of the office. Intro. by Blust.
