TO PROVIDE AN APPURTENANCE TOLERANCE OF SIX INCHES FOR RECREATIONAL VEHICLES AND TO INCREASE THE ALLOWABLE LENGTH OF A COMBINATION OF VEHICLES THAT INCLUDES A RECREATIONAL VEHICLE FROM FIFTY-FIVE FEET TO SIXTY-FIVE FEET. Amends GS 20-116 to: (1) allow six inches on each side of vehicles for non-load bearing appurtenances; (2) remove the prohibition on recreation vehicles with a load extending six inches beyond the fenders; and (3) increase the allowable total length of two vehicles attached together, that includes a recreational vehicle, from 55 feet to 65 feet.

H 266. RV APPURTENANCE EXEMPTION. Filed 2/19/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Modifies GS 20-116 to require that awnings of recreational vehicles must be secured in the closed position to be in compliance with the requirements of the appurtenance tolerance of six inches for recreational vehicles. Removes changes to GS 20-116(e) that would have increased the allowable length of a combination of vehicles that includes a recreational vehicle from 55 to 65 feet. Makes conforming changes to title.
