H 32. SUSPEND INVOLUNTARY ANNEXATIONS. Filed 1/29/07. TO SUSPEND INVOLUNTARY ANNEXATIONS AND TO ESTABLISH A BLUE RIBBON COMMISSION TO STUDY INVOLUNTARY ANNEXATIONS. As title indicates, creates a 10-member Legislative Study Commission and prohibits municipalities from initiating or continuing involuntary annexations until the commission has submitted a final report to the 2009 General Assembly and the General Assembly has acted on the findings and recommendations. Requires that commission study current statutory procedures for involuntary annexations by municipalities, including whether those procedures adequately protect the rights of property owners and the adequacy of remedies available to property owners.
