H 451. JOINT STUDY COMPLEMENTARY/ALTERNATIVE MED. Filed 3/1/07. TO ESTABLISH THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE STUDY COMMISSION ON COMPLEMENTARY AND ALTERNATIVE FORMS OF MEDICINE.

Creates the Joint Legislative Study Committee on Complementary and Alternative Forms of Medicine in North Carolina, consisting of 12 members. The committee must consider (1) the types of complementary and alternative health care services offered and used in NC, (2) ways to facilitate access to complementary and alternative health care practitioners, (3) the impact of Health Freedom legislation in other states, (4) the need for mandatory licensure of complementary and alternative health care services practitioners, and (5) any other matter the committee considers appropriate. The committee must submit a report on its findings to the 2008 Regular Session or to the 2009 General Assembly upon its convening. Directs the Legislative Services Commission to allocate funds for the committee's expenses.
