H 465. CARRBORO CAMPAIGN REGULATION. Filed 3/1/07. TO AMEND THE CARRBORO CHARTER TO ALLOW THE TOWN TO REQUIRE CANDIDATES FOR ELECTIVE TOWN OFFICE TO DISCLOSE THE NAMES OF CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTORS AND TO LIMIT BY ORDINANCE THE AMOUNT THAT PERSONS MAY CONTRIBUTE TO A CANDIDATE OR THEIR POLITICAL COMMITTEE.

Enacts Section 2-8 to the Town of Carrboro Charter, SL 1987-476, allowing the town to enact an ordinance requiring candidates for elective town office to disclose the names of campaign contributors. Enacts Section 2-9 allowing the town to enact an ordinance limiting the amount any individual, person, or political committee may contribute to candidates for town office. Enacts Section 2-10 providing that the definitions in Article 22A of GS Chapter 163 apply to Sections 2-8 and 2-9. Repeals Section 2-7 of the Charter. Intro. by Insko. ORANGE
