Repeals Section 3(b) of SL 2005-345, which amended GS 58-50-30(a)(3) to prohibit insurers from charging higher co-payments for service by chiropractors than the co-payments they charge for service by primary care physicians for comparable medically necessary treatment. Act does not affect co-payments for services provided before it becomes law.

**H 502. REPEAL CHIROPRACTIC SPECIAL PROVISION.** Filed 3/6/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Specifies the act is effective October 1, 2007, and applies to health insurance policies issued on or after that date. Provides that for purposes of the act, the renewal of a health benefit plan is presumed to occur on each anniversary of the date on which coverage was first effective for the person covered by the health benefit plan.
