H 511. BIDS/COMPLY WITH FEDERAL TRANSIT LAW. Filed 3/6/07. AUTHORIZING POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OF THE STATE TO ACCEPT BIDS FROM UNLICENSED GENERAL CONTRACTORS WHEN THE PROJECT IS FINANCED WITH FEDERAL TRANSIT FUNDS AND THE FEDERAL LAW REQUIRES ONLY THAT GENERAL CONTRACTORS MUST BE LICENSED BY THE TIME THE LOCAL GOVERNING BOARD AWARDS THE CONTRACT.

Amends GS 87-9 to clarify that the article (general contractors) does not prevent political subdivisions of the state from complying with federal law or with regulations for carrying out the Federal Transit Act and that the article does not apply to a person submitting bids to enter into a contract for work financed with federal transit funds in a way that conflicts with federal law or regulations.
