H 514. INCREASE LENGTH LIMITS FOR TRANSIT BUSES. Filed 3/6/07. *TO ALLOW PASSENGER BUSES THAT HAVE AN OVERALL LENGTH OF SIXTY-ONE FEET TO OPERATE ON PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS.*

Amends GS 20-116 to allow passenger buses 61 feet or less long, and owned and operated by units of local government to operate on public streets and highways. Also authorizes the Department of Transportation to prevent the operation of authorized buses if the buses prevent a hazard to passengers or the public. Effective July 1, 2007.

H 514. INCREASE LENGTH LIMITS FOR TRANSIT BUSES. Filed 3/6/07. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Modifies proposed GS 20-116(l) to authorize the operation of passenger buses owned and operated by a unit of local government that (1) are single vehicles (was, or a combination of vehicles coupled together) and (2) have an overall length of 45 feet or less (was, 61 feet or less). Effective when the act becomes law (was, July 1, 2007). Conforms the title.
