H 548. BREVARD MAYOR'S FOUR-YEAR TERM. Filed 3/7/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Amends Section 2.6 of the Brevard city charter, SL 1981-475, to provide that if there is a vacancy in the office of mayor during the first two years of the term, the city council may fill the vacancy by majority vote until the next election, at which time the voters will elect a replacement for the remaining two years; if the vacancy occurs during the final two years of the term, the city council may fill the vacancy by majority vote (was, if a vacancy occurs, it may be filled by the city council by a majority vote). Makes conforming change to Section 3.2 of the Brevard city charter. Changes effective date from beginning with the mayor elected in 2009 to January 1, 2009, and applying to mayoral elections conducted thereafter.

H 548. BREVARD MAYOR'S FOUR-YEAR TERM. Filed 3/7/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Deletes specific provisions for the council filling a mayoral vacancy and substitutes the general law process of GS 160A-63 for that purpose.
