Enacts GS 58-84-60 to provide immunity from civil liability for monetary damages, except to the extent covered by insurance, for an act or the failure to act arising out of service on a local board of trustees for the Firemen's Relief Fund. Exceptions are acts outside the scope of official duties, not committed in good faith, amounting to gross negligence or willful and wanton misconduct, resulting in an improper personal financial benefit, or resulting from the operation of a motor vehicle. Applies to causes of action arising on or after October 1, 2007.
