[Under current law, the State Board of Community Colleges may provide a program of study for lateral entry teachers to complete the coursework needed to obtain a teaching certificate if those individuals (1) possess a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution (2) have completed the bachelor's degree at least five years before beginning the study for lateral entry teachers (3) hold a lateral entry teaching certificate and (4) are employed as teachers in a local school administrative unit.] Effective July 1, 2007, and expires July 1, 2011.
