H 589. POULTRY PRODUCTS INSPECTION ACT PENALTIES. Filed 3/12/07. *TO PROVIDE FOR CIVIL PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE POULTRY PRODUCTS INSPECTION ACT.*

Amends GS 106-549.35 to include Article 49D (Poultry Products Inspection Act) in those articles of GS Chapter 106 for violations of which the North Carolina Commissioner of Agriculture may assess civil penalties of no more than \$5,000. Also allows the civil penalty to be applied to rules adopted under Article 49B or 49D (was, Article 49B or 49C). Effective for penalties assessed on or after October 1, 2007.

H 589. POULTRY PRODUCTS INSPECTION ACT PENALTIES. Filed 3/12/07. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Deletes proposed changes to GS 106-549.35(c) and instead enacts new GS 106-549.59(a1) allowing the Commissioner of Agriculture to assess a civil penalty of up to \$5,000 against a person who violates the Poultry Products Inspection Act; the penalty must be remitted to the Civil Penalty and Forfeiture Fund.
