Enacts GS 121-5.1 to establish a ten-member State Historical Records Advisory Board. Members are appointed by the Governor to three-year staggered terms. Sets duties of Board, provides procedures for removal and filling vacancies, designates a state coordinator for the Board, and requires at least two meetings per year.

H 645. STATE HISTORICAL RECORDS ADVISORY BOARD. Filed 3/14/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Authorizes the continuation of the existing State Historical Records Advisory Board (Board) (was, established the Board). Provides that the current members continue to serve until their terms expire or a member is removed or the position becomes vacant. Reduces from ten to eight the proposed number of members to be appointed by the Governor, thus reducing from twelve to ten the proposed total membership of the Board. Makes conforming change to the bill title.
