H 680. OMNIBUS LABOR LAW CHANGES. Filed 3/14/07. TO MAKE TECHNICAL AND OTHER CHANGES TO THE UNIFORM BOILER AND PRESSURE VESSEL ACT AND TO REVISE SERVICE REQUIREMENTS TO CONFORM WITH RULE 4 OF THE NORTH CAROLINA RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE.

Amends GS 95-69.10 by (1) deleting subsection (b)(5) ("pressure vessels used for transportation or storage of liquefied petroleum gas") from the list of vessels to which the Uniform Boiler and Pressure Vessel Act apply; (2) substituting the more specific phrase "railway safety regulations pursuant to 49 C.F.R. 230" for the more general "safety regulations" in subsection (b)(11); and adding new subsection (g) providing that inspection requirement established by the Department of Labor shall not apply to pressure vessels used for transportation or storage of liquefied petroleum gas that are subject to inspection pursuant to Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services regulations. Amends GS 95-69-15 by deleting subsection (c) providing for the issuance of certificates of competency. Amends GS 95-69.16 by reducing the grace period during which a boiler or pressure vessel may be operated without an inspection certificate from 90 days to 60 days. Amends GS 95-25.23(a), GS 95-25.23A(a), GS 95-69.19(d), GS 95-110.10(e), GS 95-111.13(g), GS 95-123, GS 95-137(b) and GS 95-234(a) by adding to the methods of delivering an exception to the Commissioner of Labor's findings certified mail with return receipt, by signature confirmation as provided by the U.S. Postal Service, and hand delivery.
