H 768. DISCOVERY/DA WORK PRODUCT & CONFID. INFORMANT. Filed 3/14/07. *TO CLARIFY THAT THE STATE IS NOT REQUIRED TO DISCLOSE THE IDENTITY OF A CONFIDENTIAL INFORMANT IN A CRIMINAL CASE UNLESS DISCLOSURE IS OTHERWISE REQUIRED BY LAW, AND TO PROTECT THE WORK PRODUCT OF PROSECUTORS.*

Amends GS 15A-904 to provide that the state is not required to disclose the identity of a confidential informant unless otherwise required by law and deletes provision that documents prepared by the prosecuting attorney and staff do not have to be disclosed only to the extent they contain the opinions, theories, strategies, or conclusions of the prosecuting attorney and staff.
