Enacts new GS Chapter 113C prohibiting the sale of incandescent and halogen lamps and includes a list of lamps not included in the section. Effective January 1, 2016.

**H 838. STUDY INCANDESCENT & FLUORESCENT LAMP ISSUES (NEW).** Filed 3/14/07.

House committee substitute deletes the provisions of the 1st edition and replaces it with *AN ACT TO DIRECT THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY AND DESIRABILITY OF PHASING OUT THE USE OF INCANDESCENT LAMPS AND TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO DEVELOP A PROPOSAL FOR A RECYCLING PROGRAM FOR FLUORESCENT LAMPS.* Directs the Environmental Review Commission to study phasing out the use of incandescent lamps and replacing them with more energy efficient forms of lighting and report its findings to the 2008 Regular Session of the General Assembly. Requires the Division of Waste Management and the Division of Pollution Prevention and Environmental Assistance of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) to jointly develop a proposal for a fluorescent lamp recycling program. DENR must report its findings, including cost estimates, to the Environmental Review Commission by March 1, 2008.
