H 906. NO PENALTY FOR TEACHERS TAKING PERSONAL LEAVE. Filed 3/19/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Modifies GS 115C-302.1(d) to require that a teacher's request for personal leave be automatically granted if the request is made at least five days in advance to the teacher's immediate supervisor. Also allows teachers to use up to two personal leave days per year and receive full salary with no substitute deduction and provides that teachers using more than two days per year receive full salary minus the required substitute deduction. Defines *teachers* as including classroom teachers and media specialists who require a substitute.
