Modifies proposed amendment to GS 126-1.1 defining *career state employee* by including employees continuously employed by local entities in positions subject to the State Personnel Act for the immediate 24 preceding months.

S 1023. LOCAL SPA EMPLOYEE STATUS/UNC PUBLIC RECORDS (NEW). Filed 3/20/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Changes the title to *AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE STATUS OF LOCAL ENTITY EMPLOYEES SUBJECT TO THE STATE PERSONNEL ACT, TO MODIFY THE PUBLIC RECORDS LAWS APPLICABLE TO THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AND THE NORTH CAROLINA COMMUNITY COLLEGES, TO PROTECT THE PRIVACY OF APPLICANTS WHO ARE NOT ADMITTED OR WHO DO NOT ENROLL, AND TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN AUDIT RECORDS ARE PUBLIC DOCUMENTS.* Enacts new GS 132-1.1(f) to provide that UNC system and Community College system records of applicants for admission are confidential, except that records containing communications from elected officials concerning applicants who have not enrolled are subject to disclosure. Amends GS 116-40.7(c) to make audit work papers public after completion of the audit report, subject to the right of the custodian to redact specified personal identifying information.
