S 1065. COMM. COLL. TUITION SURCHARGE/SCHOLARSHIPS. Filed 3/20/07. AUTHORIZING COMMUNITY COLLEGES TO IMPLEMENT A TUITION SURCHARGE AND TO USE ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS TO OFFSET THE COST OF A TUITION SURCHARGE.

Enacts new GS 115D-39.1 as title indicates and provides that the tuition surcharge may be up to 33 1/3% of the statewide tuition rate to fund a new instructional program that is necessary to attract industry to the area. Requires the approval of the State Board of Community Colleges (SBCC) in order for community colleges to implement the tuition surcharge and use endowed scholarship funds to offset the surcharge. Specifies students for whom the surcharge applies; restricts application of the section only to endowed scholarship funds in excess of \$5 million; and directs the SBCC to adopt rules to implement the section.
