Provides for a task force and for the allocation of the funds. Requires the Department of Health and Human Services to report to several legislative committees and divisions by May 1, 2008, on the allocation of funds and program implementation, and report again, by March 1, 2009, on employee participation in the pilot programs and health outcomes.
