S 119. IN-STATE TUITION/DEPT. OF DEFENSE EMPLOYEES. Filed 2/8/07. TO PROVIDE THAT EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE AND THEIR DEPENDENTS SHALL QUALIFY FOR THE IN-STATE TUITION RATE. Enacts new GS 116-143.7 (tuition of employees of the Department of Defense and their dependents) charging in-state tuition rates to employees and the dependents of employees of the Department of Defense that are stationed in North Carolina and have been admitted to institutions of the University of North Carolina and the community colleges under the jurisdiction of the State Board of Community Colleges. If the employee is reassigned out of state, the employee and his or her dependents remain eligible for in-state tuition as long as they are continuously enrolled in the program they were enrolled in when they were reassigned. Effective July 1, 2007 and applies to the 2007-08 academic year. Intro. by Rand. GS 116

S 119. IN-STATE TUITION/DEPT. OF DEFENSE EMPLOYEES. Filed 2/8/07. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Modifies proposed new GS 116-143.7 to define *abode* and make technical change. Amends GS 115D-39(a) to include reference to tuition under new GS 116-143.7 and to include the United States Department of Defense in those ordering personnel transfers or paying tuition. Amends GS 116-21.3 to allow employees of the Department of Defense enrolled as full-time students or as a licensure student, not qualifying for resident tuition, to be eligible for a legislative tuition grant. Amends GS 116-22(2), GS 116-43.5(a)(3), and GS 116-143.4 to include reference to tuition under GS 116-143.7. Amends GS 116-235(b)(1) to allow students living with a parent who is an employee of the Department of Defense living in the state incident to employment at the time of application to be considered for admission to the North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics.

S 119. IN-STATE TUITION FOR DOD EMPS/TUITION REFUND (NEW). Filed 2/8/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Amends GS 115D-89(a) to add tuition refund policies to the State Board of Community Colleges' standards that must be met by schools for which the Board may grant and issue licenses. Changes the effective date from July 1, 2007, to when the act becomes law.
