S 120. FUND ONLY ONE SCHOOL SYSTEM PER COUNTY. Filed 2/8/07. *DIRECTING THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR ONLY ONE LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT PER COUNTY.* As title indicates, directs the State Board of Education (Board) to change formulas allocating funds on a per local school administrative unit (unit) basis to formulas that allocate funds on a per county basis. Requires changing previous graduated funding allotments based on average daily membership (ADM) to graduated funding allotments based on the ADM of all units located in the county. If a city school unit is located in more than one county, the Board must include in each respective county's ADM, the ADM of that county's students in the city school unit. If a county contains more than one unit, directs the Board to divide the funding allotment between the units based on the units' respective ADM. Specifies that the act does not apply to allotments in the following units: Nash-Rocky Mount Schools, Edgecombe County Schools, Cleveland County Schools, or Gaston County Schools. Effective July 1, 2007.
